

## Southern Boone Economic Development Council Location: Jose Jalapenos Minutes for August 9<sup>th</sup>, 4:00 PM

Due to a lack of quorum, the meeting was not called to order. The following individuals met to have discussions around items included on the agenda and other topics of interest to SBEDC.

Liz Heyen provided an update and recap of the REDI social event at Eagle Knoll in July. She provided comments from a few businesses that sent messages in response to SBEDC thankyou note.

Brandon Glascock provided an update on an email received from Socket requesting SBEDC support via a letter of support on an upcoming grant application to help extend Socket's fiber network throughout the unincorporated areas of Southern Boone County. Discussion ensued with regards to the proposed letter of support language provided by Socket. Brandon indicated he would follow up with Socket for clarification on the grant and would follow up with the Board to get approval on a letter of support.

Dave Westhoff provided an update on Ranken's construction process and gave an overview of the proposed phase 2 project he is spearheading with job training assistance from Ranken. Carson Blake assisted with giving an overview of the HarvestUp project proposed as phase 2. Discussion ensued regarding the project, project timeline, implications for Ashland, Southern Boone County, and the central Missouri region. Matt Boyce and Jason Reynolds provided additional update information regarding the website and the need for additional content and better integration/utilization of social media to show projects underway like Scooters, Ranken, and Taco Bell when it breaks ground.
