The Ashland Betterment Coalition meets on the first Monday of every month at 7pm in the Community Room at City Hall. These are open meetings and we always welcome community members who want to be involved or volunteer.

Planters have had great feed back and we are in action to have two more locations for the spring. We are placing these on a first come first serve basis, so that is how we are choosing the locations for now and will move down the list accordingly. After the trial run of 3 planters, we realized they are going to be more costly than anticipated to keep and establish. That being said, we are looking for volunteers to be on a rotation of planter care as well as material donors so our input cost is not as high. There are 4 businesses on the wait list for planters.

We have our Santa and live reindeer event coming up December 8,202. This is a family friendly event to encourage people to visit our business district. Santa and Mrs. Clause will be there for kids to visit with and live reindeer will be there. We are looking for two exclusive sponsors that event at \$500 a piece.

The group is working on a better process for requests of accepting/declining sponsorships and launching the facade grant opportunity.
